



FAMILY VIOLENCE SERVICES

Whenever Victoria Police attend a family violence incident, they are required to complete a Family Violence Report for the victim survivor and the perpetrator.

If an incident occurs within the City of Casey, Cardinia Shire or the City of Greater Dandenong local government areas, the Family Violence Report is sent to Wayss for response. A Wayss Family Violence Specialist then reaches out to the victim survivor and offers immediate support.

The figures in table one below reflect the number of individual victim survivors Wayss has made contact with from Family Violence Reports. Some victim survivors we contact choose to be referred to Wayss support services, others may choose support services in different areas, while some choose not to access support services.

Table two reflects the number of victim survivors who have been supported by Wayss family violence support services.

HOUSING SUPPORT SERVICES

Wayss offers crisis, medium and long-term housing options for people escaping family violence and for people who are homeless. We also support people who are at risk of losing their housing.

Wayss currently manages 542 tenancies including an eight unit high-risk refuge for women and children, and a youth refuge supporting young people aged 16-25 who are homeless.

Support requested is generally crisis accommodation due to immediate or imminent homelessness; financial support to clear rental arrears or funds for rent in advance for a new tenancy.
